





Ritchey Science & Engineering Fair (SEF) Read Me First!

The documents included in the Ritchey SEF Fall Virtual Workshop online website (Ritchey SEF Virtual Workshop Materials) are a combination of Handouts and Video presentations created by the faculty at the Weber State University plus documents from the Regeneron International Science & Engineering Fair, the Society for Science, and Weber State University's supporting colleges.

Regeneron ISEF (International Science & Engineering Fair) forms are <u>required</u> for all senior projects being considered for the ISEF competition at the Ritchey SEF <u>Senior</u> Fair (9th-12th grades) only. Senior fair students will need to upload their forms as PDFs to the Ritchey SEF registration website: https://ritchev.zfairs.com/ during the registration period between Feb 1 and Feb 29, 2024.

ISEF forms for <u>senior</u> fair students are available here: (https://www.societyforscience.org/isef/forms/). If you are unsure which forms you will need to fill in for your project, ISEF has a forms wizard to help you: https://ruleswizard.societyforscience.org. We strongly recommend that students use this forms wizard.

All senior fair students need to fill in **ISEF forms: 1, 1A, 1B, and the research plan <u>before</u>** starting experiment or engineering projects—which probably means right now! Some students will also need to fill in additional forms depending on the type of project you choose.

An important online document is the **02_Ritchey_SEF_2024.pdf**, which lists the dates of the junior and senior fairs as well as the categories. Both junior and senior divisions have the same categories.

Another valuable document is the **03_Online_Resources_2024.pdf**. You should be able to click on the links within this document and access the online science and engineering resources. We checked each of these links, but as with anything Internet, links can change at any time. Please send us an email note if you notice a broken link.
