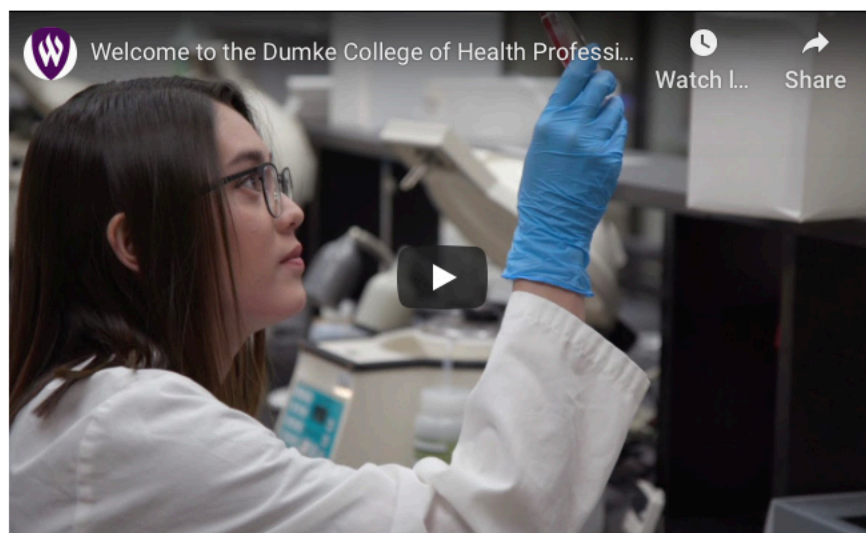




Dumke College of Health Professions Office of Admissions Advisement
